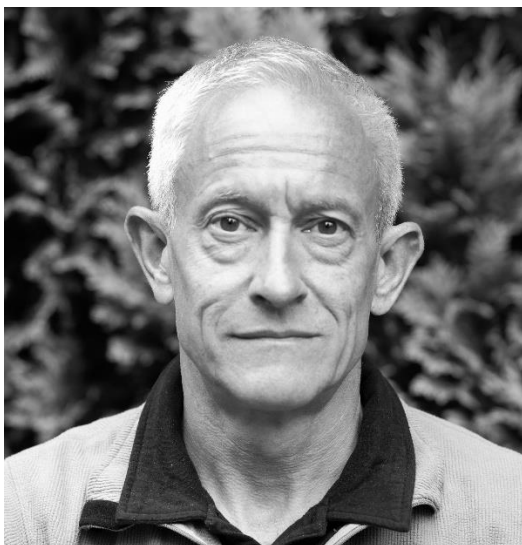


Speaker Bios - SIAS Talk: New ways to approach the greatest challenges (26th February 2026)

Colin Wilson has had a varied actuarial career, starting in life insurance and investment before moving into wider risk management and government. He was UK Deputy Government Actuary from 2012 to 2022 and served as President of the IFoA from 2016 to 2017.
